Road and Time Trial Categories

Solo riders are entered into either the Road Bike or Time Trial Bike category, as indicated in the start list below. A rider can change category on the day by informing one of the race officials at sign-on.

The Road Bike category is governed by the following rules:

No aerobars, clip on aerobars or aero extensions can be used

Hands must be holding the handlebars at all times whilst racing (i.e. not with forearms resting on the handlebar)

Wheels must have a minimum of 12 spokes each, and have a maximum rim depth of 90mm


Helmets must have no visor

Ears must not be covered by the helmet (Giro Aerohead helmets, for example, are not permitted).
