


Event HQ and the Course:

The **HQ** will be positioned at **The Eyre Arms** (Post Code: S32 3XH) **PLEASE NOTE CHANGE FROM PREVIOUS YEARS.**

Please **sign on** and collect your **number** and **drink token** at the **HQ**. Signing on will be available from **6pm**.

Please **sign out** and return your number after the event otherwise all your hard efforts will be in vain! The HQ is approximately **1 mile from the start.** No **U turns in sight of the start or finish.**

Warm up: Please avoid warming up on the road between the HQ and the start once the event has started. There is plenty of road available going north (towards Grindleford and Froggatt) and east (towards Baslow) from the HQ.

The details:

Starting:

Try to avoid arriving at the start more than 5 minutes before your start time, and please come to the start line when your name and/or number is called. Last year one of the competitors was mistaken for a cake which resulted in him missing his start time.

Parking/refreshments and loos:

Parking is available in the Eyre Arms carpark, Polly Froggatt Lane and the A625 in the direction of Grindleford. Toilets are available in the pub. Food can be purchased from the Eyre Arms, but please note that the kitchen closes at 8pm.

Road Bike event

Please ensure that your bike and attire meet the following criteria if you are competing in the road bike event:

- No tri bars (or other clip-on bars)
- Wheels: no disc wheel and rims no deeper than 60mm (not including the tyre)
- No aero helmet, i.e. nothing pointy.
- No helmet visors

Helmets

IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD-SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

ALL JUNIOR competitors MUST wear a helmet – regardless if the competitor is 18.

Lights

An illuminated **rear light and front light**, either constant or flashing, must be affixed to your machine in a position that is clearly visible to other road users. **No lights = no ride**.

Parental permission

All riders who are **under 18** must have a **SIGNED PARENTAL PERMISSION** form. These can be handed in when you sign on. Please leave in the box on the signing on table.

Body numbers

Your number should be fixed so it is clearly visible from the rear when in his normal riding position.

Finishing

You must ride through the finish and continue down the hill to the HQ.

Results

No times will be given at the finish. Results will be posted on a spreadsheet which will be updated in real time.
