Please take care on Sunrising Hill, which is known to be steep and slippery with a tight left hand bend on the way down. Also, please be cautious through the village of Ettington as locals have been known to be upset by speeding cyclists previously. We want to protect this course for future use so please err on the side of caution and be courteous if necessary. The early start should reduce any issues.



Will open around 7am. Parking is available as well as a coffee van where you can pick up a free coffee and possibly a cake after the event. I can vouch for the excellent quality of the coffee at least.

(4) The Course - K4/23

From the HQ, turn left out of the Sports Club and the turn right on the main road and proceed 50 metres or so to the disused pub where the START is situated. You may leave spare clothing with me at the start which can be collected at the HQ afterwards.

Proceed WNW to Ettington roundabout and return to the edge of Wroxton Village. REMEMBER, be cautious down Sunrising Hill where there is a potentially dangerous SHARP BEND. DO NOT CROSS THE SOLIDCENTRE WHITE LINE in contravention of the Highway Code or you will be disqualified. A photographer may be present there for evidential purposes as well as to capture your stylish descending technique.

Marshals will be on course to provide visibility but do take care of your own safety.

(6) NOTES & CAUTIONS

REMEMBER to sign in and then out after the event and return your number.

HELMETS & WORKING FRONT AND REAR LIGHTS ARE NOW MANDATORY AT THE START LINE. Please see the CTT Guidance Notes in case you are not familiar with the rule. I will not permit you to start unless you have all of those fitted and, in the case of lights, visibly working. No excuses.

No vehicles other than those of the timekeeper and marshals may park in the vicinity of the finish. DO NOT pass the start after the event has started.

DO NOT stop at the finish. Please carry on to the HQ where your result will be posted reasonably promptly.
