POINTS

Points will be awarded on the basis of 60 points (in each category) for the winner down to 1 for sixtieth place in each event. The winners will be the riders with the highest aggregate total of points from up to four events. If more than one rider achieves the same number of points, then their 5th highest placing will be used to determine the winner. The Veteran categories are open to both Men and Women. Women Veterans will receive an additional 8 years on Target Time. The Veterans competitions will be run over the same distance as the Women's competition. The competition for Paracyclist's is based on a "Factored Time" system. See Page 224 of the 2023 Handbook for the competition conditions.

To find the Grange Centre (HQ): It is at the top end of Midhurst on Bepton Road in the Chichester direction. If you are coming from the Petersfield direction turn right at the mini roundabout and look for the turning on the left hand side. If you are coming from either the Haslemere or Petworth direction then go up through the town and straight on over the mini roundabout, if coming from the Chichester direction you will find turning on the right just before the turning for Sainsburys, if you go over the mini roundabout, then you have gone too far. Toilets & Showers are available.

Awards will be presented after the Events, you may see the team scratching their heads but don't worry, they can be quick, but there will be five events to sort ". Please stay and applaud the Victors of the Day. **Prizes not collected on the day** will be deemed to have been donated unless prior arrangements have been made.

It is also <u>compulsory</u> that WORKING FRONT & REAR LIGHTS, either flashing or constant, are fitted to the machine in a position visible to road users and are active while the machine is in use





Road-bike Criteria - the road bike can possess drop or straight handlebars; no tri-bars, clip-on bars or Spinacci bars are allowed


No disc wheels; both front & rear wheels must have at least 12 spokes each, the maximum rim depth allowed is 90mm.

To ride to the Start: Turn right upon leaving the HQ then turn left at the mini-roundabout and head up Petersfield Road, when you get to the Half Moon PH do not despair, the start is just a little further. Allow fifteen minutes to ride to the Start. The Départ is at the end of a poorly maintained Lay-By.

The area is a very affluent part of West Sussex but the "Pot-Holes" can be deeper than those in surrounding counties, so beware & avoid, that puddle could lead to a subterranean lake.

Course Description P877

Start in lay-by on A272 West of Half Moon pub and Woolbeding turning just short of "Junction" sign (Minsted).

Depart on A272 in the direction of Petersfield pass Stedham (on the right) going straight on until Iping Crossroads. Turn left signposted Harting (1 mile). Pass straight through Ingrams Green Junction (2.2m), Elsted Marsh and Treyford Turn (3.2m)

Straight through Elsted Village (4 m) and on to East Harting and Turkey Island (5.5m), it's a bit "twisty turny" & on your left shoulder you will see the "South Downs", curb your enthusiasm, you will be climbing them in about three miles time.

In South Harting Keep left, take care through village (6.2m) (**beware** of lots of parked cars as the residents of the village haven't discovered driveways & car parks). Straight on through the village towards the church, at Junction Turn Left (6.7m) and up Harting Hill with National Trust Car Park at top of hill (we are not sure if any defibrillators are stored there) (7.5m). Straight down towards Chilgrove (11m), this is a very quick section & it does have corners, no head down riding.

At the junction with A286 sharp turn left (take care of oncoming traffic) towards Midhurst (14.5m), Through West Dean (16.2m). Take care through Singleton Village, bear left towards Midhurst (17.7m)

Straight on to Cocking Hill (20m) taking care at the foot of hill as the road bears right and through Cocking Village (20.5m). Continue on A286 to **Finish** opposite Royal Oak Pub Chichester Road Midhurst (22.5).



NOTES TO COMPETITORS

ROAD BIKE CRITERIA

- the road bike can possess drop or straight handlebars; no tri-bars, clip-on bars or Spinacci bars are allowed
- no disc wheels; both front & rear wheels must have at least 12 spokes each
- the maximum rim depth allowed is 90mm.

NUMBERS: CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITION 2(j)

Competitors must only use the numbers supplied by the event organiser. Body numbers should be fitted in accordance with Regulation 16. Arm numbers should be fitted to the upper arms facing forwards.

This event is under 100km. Riders should not be preceded, accompanied, followed by or in anyway receive assistance from a motorised vehicle.

REGULATION 14(j)

(j) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

REGULATION 14(k)

(k) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the front of their machine a working front white light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

REGULATION 15:

All competitors must wear a properly affixed helmet which must be of hard/soft shell construction. Helmets should conform to a recognised Standard such as SNELL B95, ANSI Z90.4, AUS/NZS 2063:96, DIN 33-954, CPSC or EN 1078.

REGULATION 17: SIGNING-ON SHEET AND SIGNING-OUT SHEET

(a) The competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official Signing-on Sheet when collecting their number.

(b) In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must (i) return their race number(s) and (ii) sign the official Signing-out Sheet. A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF.

N.B. Extenuating circumstances may be considered.

THIS EVENT MAY BE SUBJECT TO A DOPING CONTROL

As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is up

to you to check and ensure that you comply. If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay.
