Headquarters

The Crooked Billet Pub postcode LS24 9QN is near Saxton on the B1271 between Tadcaster and Aberford Road easly accessable from the A64 if coming fromYork or from the M1/A1 if coming from Leeds or further South.

Route from HQ to start

START on east side of A162, at southern gate-post to entrance to Council Depot, approximately 0.3 miles north of Towton.

Course details

V314 Course Details

START on east side of A162, at southern gate-post to entrance to Council Depot, approximately 0.3 miles north of Towton.

Proceed south, via Towton and Barkston Ash, to Sherburn north T.I.(3.45 mls)

Take 1st exit, left, still on A162, straight on at next island to turn at the island junction with the B1222.(4.62 mls).

Encircle island, and retrace outward route via Sherburn north T.I. towards Towton.

At junction with B1217, (8.95 mls).turn left and continue for approx. 1 mile to FINISH at mark on road approx.10yds west of junction with Cotchers Lane (on left).(10 miles)

Local regulations

Road Bike Rules:

Riders must sign on and off before and after the event at the Crooked Billet near Saxton, the club officials will be there for this purpose from 08.00.

To encourage first timers to take part in this event we are awarding a prize to the winner of the standard road bike competition, a standard road bike is defined as follows:

- 1. Road bikes with 700c wheels only.
- 2. Standard or electronic gears
- 3. No tri bars- drop bar only
- 4. No disc wheels
- 5. Deep rim permitted to maximum 50mm
- 6. No pointy helmets.
- 7. Must have working lights front and rear either flashing or constant,

Anyone wishing to be included in this classification must sign an additional signing on sheet before the event and inform the official at the start who will check their bike for compliance.

NOTES TO COMPETITORS:

17. Signing-on Sheet and Signing-out Sheet

(a) The competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official signing-on sheet when collecting their number.

(b) In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must (i) return their race number(s); and (ii) sign the official signing-out sheet. A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF.

This event may be subject to a Doping Control As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply. If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay.
