Route from HQ to start

From HQ proceed to the T junction (Drayton Road) and turn right onto Main Road and continue out of the village to the A6116 (Lowick Bypass). Turn left

onto A6116 (take care) a d proceed to start (first layby on the left). Please allow approx 10 mins to start.

Course details

START On the A6116 (Lowick Bypass) in line with drain cover at north end of lay-by, just after junction with road into Lowick. Proceed northwards towards Stanion on the A6116 to the Roundabout with A43 where care needed

Turn Left (M) taking first exit and proceed towards Geddington, straight on through the village on A43, to Roundabout (M) taking first exit proceeding through Weekly village to

Turn Left (M) onto unclassified road to Warkton village (Care on narrow bridge) Proceed through Warkton to Grafton Underwood crossroads (M), straight on to Slipton village where riders need to keep to the left to avoid oncoming traffic, and at the bottom of the hill turn right (M) (care) and proceed to junction with old A604 where

Turn Left (M) proceed towards Thrapston to Roundabout with A6116 where

Turn Left (M) taking first exit onto A6116. Proceed north to

Turn Left (M) into old road into Lowick Village (Short of Lay-by starting point) to

FINISH In line with North end of Brick Bridge on right hand side, just before large opening into field. (20 miles)

After the Finish continue to the Village Hall HQ in Lowick.

Local regulations

Parking

Riders can park outside the hall or anywhere in the village, please be courteous if using the pub car park and do not consume the parking areas as they will wish to have spaces for their customers.

Do not park too close to finish.

Drayton Road is a dead end, there is a turning point at the bottom as it turns into a gated road. At all times please be courteous to residents.

Parking at start and finish only by race officials.

Safety Instructions

All issues affecting competitors as identified by the risk assessment.

Safety Advice

Course note * There are two Pelican crossings in Geddington, please be aware of them. Course note ** There is a narrow bridge as you enter Warkton, please be aware of oncoming traffic as this is of a single vehicle width

Parts of the course are on unclassified roads requiring extreme caution.

Hard-shell Helmets are compulsory. In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a hard-shell Helmet that meets an internationally accepted standard.

It is compulsory that working front and rear lights either flashing or constant, are fitted to the machine in a position visible to other road users and are active while the machine is in use. Any rider without working lights will be disgualified.

Any rider performing a 'U' turn within sight of the start or finish may be disqualified (A 'U' turn is defined as a 180-degree turn completed within the width of the carriageway whilst astride the machine. It is recommended that riders should dismount, check the road is clear in both directions then, with machine, walk across the road.)

Race Numbers

Please sign in at HQ where number can be collected.

Please note that all competitors are required to personally sign the signing out sheet when returning their number. Failure to do so will result in the competitor being recorded as D.N.F.

Return Race Number to HQ (NOT start or finish) and exchange for a drink.

No times will be given to competitors at the finish area.

- 17. Signing-on Sheet and Signing-out Sheet
- (a) The competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official signing-on sheet when collecting their number.
- (b) In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must (i) return their race number(s); and (ii) sign the official signing-out sheet. A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF.

This event may be subject to a Doping Control As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply. If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay.
