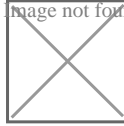

Headquarters

HQ: The Village Hall, Main Road, Goostrey, Cheshire, CW4 8PE

Open at 12.45pm for registration and collection of race numbers.

There are toilet facilities, and tea, coffee and snacks will be available throughout the afternoon.

Parking is an issue, please respect fellow riders and local residents

If you are unable to ride, please contact the event secretary.

Route from HQ to start

Directions to start:

Turn right out of HQ onto Station Road, take 1st left onto Church Bank which then becomes Blackenden Lane. After approx. 1.5 miles take right hand fork followed by left hand fork onto Bomish lane, the start is just over the railway bridge. Total distance from HQ to start is 1.9 miles, please allow enough time

Course details

COURSE J 2/9 25 miles

START At A "JS2" mark in Bomish Lane (Jodrell Bank to Goostrey road). At a telegraph pole No 2 approx. 300yds west of the A535. Proceed East to the A535 and forward on the A535 to:-

CHELFORD ISLAND 2.169 m 2nd exit left on the A537 to Seven Sisters lane at:-

OLLERTON CROSS ROADS 5.219 m left along the lane to the A50 and left on the A50 to Twemlow Lane at:-

CRANAGE 11.408 m left into and along the lane to join the A535 at Twemlow Green, left to:-

CHELFORD ISLAND 18.064 m 2nd exit left on the A537 to Seven Sisters Lane at

OLLERTON CROSS ROADS 21.052 m left along the lane to the A50 and, left on the A50 to:-

FINISH 25.000 m At a "JF2" mark opposite the right hand field gate post opposite and just before the entrance to the Mount Pleasant Nursing Home, approx 500yds. past the cross roads after the Drovers Public House.

NOTES:

1 No parking at the start or finish. Vehicles must not be parked, however briefly, in any part of the access area to Mount Pleasant Nursing Home, opposite the finish.

2 Riders must not stop at the finish but should continue on to the event headquarters where times will be displayed.

Local regulations

Regulations:

Riders must exercise caution at all junctions. Any competitor who crosses the white line when approaching or leaving a junction will be liable to disqualification from the event and may be report to the District Committee for further disciplinary action.

No "U" turns in the vicinity of the start and finish. Observers will be watching.

Head up and observe local regulations at all times.

Pace must not be given or received and the onus is on the caught riders to adhere to this rule.

ALL RIDERS MUST SIGN THEIR OWN NUMBER BACK IN AT THE FINISH, OR WILL BE CONSIDERED DNF

This event may be subject to doping control.

Warnings:

1 Riders must not stop at the finish but should continue on to the event headquarters where times will be displayed.

2 Riders must negotiate Chelford Island in a safe and sensible manner in accordance with CTT Reg. 20 and the rules of the road. Riders must be able to brake and stop at the island if traffic conditions require this. **Riders MUST NOT approach and encircle the island using tri-bars.**

Remember - traffic on the island has priority over traffic (including riders) entering it. Any rider seen to be in breach of this regulation will be disqualified from the event and may be reported for further disciplinary action.

3 Riders must take extra care when exiting from Seven Sisters Lane onto the A50

4 Be aware that there is a double bend shortly after turning into Twemlow Lane at Cranage. Riders need to anticipate this and be prepared to negotiate it in a safe manner. In wet weather the metal covers and edges become a skid risk.

NOTES TO COMPETITORS:**17. Signing-on Sheet and Signing-out Sheet**

(a) The competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official signing-on sheet when collecting their number.

(b) In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must (i) return their race number(s); and (ii) sign the official signing-out sheet. A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF.

This event may be subject to a Doping Control As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply. If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay.
